TO ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS, please note the following changes or clarifications:

1. Sheet 4 of 6, Grading Plan with a revision date of April 3 2009 Addendum No. 1 supersedes all other Grading Plans found in the Bid Documents.
2. Edge Restraint detail as found on sheet 6 of 6 of the Bid Documents:
 - A. Wood slat edge shall be pressure treated southern yellow pine with an overall dimension of 3/4"x4".
3. Clarification regarding clearing and grubbing:
 - A. All wood brush debris from the tree clearing operations shall be chipped. Wood chips to be used on site for erosion control methods. All remaining material to be evenly dispersed in the forested areas to a depth of no more than three (3) inches.
4. Stone Dust Track & Enviroseal & Aggregate Track Typical Section as found on sheet 6 of 6 of the Bid Documents:
 - A. Compacted aggregate base use under both track options to be six (6) inches in depth.

- B. Bidder has visited the site of the proposed work and has become familiar with, and is satisfied as to, the general, local and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the work.
- C. Bidder is familiar with and is satisfied as to all Federal, State and local Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress and performance of the work.
- D. - 5.1 Bidder hereby certifies that Bidder is able to furnish labor that can work in harmony with all other elements of labor employed or to be employed on the work and that Bidder will comply fully with all applicable laws and regulations.

- 5.2 Bidder certifies under penalty of perjury that Bidder is not presently debarred from doing public construction work in the State of Connecticut under the provisions of or any other applicable debarment provisions of any other chapter of the General Laws or any rule or regulation promulgated thereunder.
- 5.3 Bidder agrees that, if this Bid is accepted, Bidder will within five days, Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excluded, after presentation thereof by Owner, execute a Subcontract Agreement in accordance with the terms of this Bid and furnish a performance bond and also a labor and materials or payment bond, each of the surety company qualified to do business under the laws of the State of Connecticut and satisfactory to Owner and each in the sum of the Contract Price, the premiums for which are to be paid by the Bidder and are included in the Contract Price.
- 5.4 Bidder will submit written evidence of its authority to do business in the State where the Project is located not later than the date of its execution of the Agreement.
- 5.5 Bidder agrees that the Work will be substantially completed and ready for final payment on or before the dates or within the number of calendar days indicated in the Agreement.
- 5.6 Bidder hereby certifies under the penalties of perjury, to the best of Bidder's knowledge and belief, that Bidder has filed all State tax returns and paid all State taxes required by law.
- 5.7 Bidder further certifies under the penalties of perjury that this Bid is in all respects bona fide, fair and made without collusion or fraud with any other person. As used in this subsection the word "person" shall mean any natural person, joint venture, partnership, corporation or other business or legal entity.

Bidder has not sought by collusion to obtain for itself any advantage over any other Bidder or over Owner.
