

Notification of the Upcoming Municipal Election in Woodbridge May 4, 2009

Special Voter Registration Sessions

The Woodbridge Registrars of Voters will be holding Special Voter Registration sessions and updating the voter lists on the following dates for the Municipal Election on May 4, 2009. Please note all cutoff dates for voter registration in bold.

Tuesday, March 31- 9am to 11am	Session to complete preliminary registry list. The active voter list will be available at the Office of the Town Clerk, and on the town website.
Wednesday, April 8 – 9am to 1pm	Voter Registration and Registrars' Session
Saturday, April 18- 10am to 2pm	Voter Registration Session
Monday, April 20 th	Cutoff date to register by mail. Cards must be postmarked by this date.
Monday, April 27 th - 9am to 8pm	Voter registration cutoff. Last day to register to vote in person.
Friday, May 1 – 9:00 am to 12:00 PM	Limited Registration Session to admit those voters whose qualifications changed as to age, citizenship or residence <u>since</u> April 27th.

The Town Clerk's Office is available to register voters Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 4:00 PM through April 27th, 2009. Active voter lists may be found on the town website.

All special voter sessions will be at the Town Hall.

The municipal election is Monday, May 4, at the Center School gymnasium, across from the town library. Polls are open from 6:00 am until 8:00 pm.

Please note that the Amity Budget Referendum will be held the following Wednesday, May 6. Voting is also at the Center School gymnasium from 6:00 am until 8:00 pm.
