The Town of Woodbridge is providing a **Public Informational Forum** for the Town Center Sidewalk and Pedestrian Safety Project, which is currently in the final design phase.

This project involves constructing approximately 880 linear feet of concrete sidewalk on the south side of Meetinghouse Lane and the west side of Newton Road.

The project will also include installing storm drainage along the west side of Newton Road and site lighting along the Meetinghouse Lane section of the walks.

The project's goal is to improve pedestrian safety in the Woodbridge Town Center, especially for Amity Regional High School students.

Construction of this project is estimated to cost \$540,000 and is funded through the CTDOT Community Connectivity Grant Program.

It is the Town's policy to keep persons informed and involved when such projects are undertaken. It is important that the community share its concerns to assist in the project's development.
